

EXPOSITION DIRECTORS PREPARE RESIGNATIONS

ABANDON EFFORT TO SECURE AID OF PARK BOARD

Meeting of Stockholders Is Called for Tuesday Night At Booklover's Hall. OUTCOME PROBLEMATICAL

President U. S. Grant, Jr., Vice President John D. Spreckels, Acting Director General Joseph W. Sefton, Jr. and Director William Clayton, of the Panama-California exposition, have written their resignations to the board of directors and will present them in full board meeting Wednesday.

Further Efforts Futile. To the Board of Directors of the Panama-California Exposition company: I herewith resign as president of your board and as director. I regard as futile any further effort to secure aid of the board of directors of the city and the present park board.
