My dear Mr. Olmsted:-

I am very much interested in having the west border of the park improved, and had Mr. Blossom at work making plans for planting the east side of the boulevard to correspond with the west, and at the same time do further planting on the west side, so that there would be more of a bunched appearance, rather than the scattered appearance it now has. Can you give us any advice as to what to do in this matter?

Furthermore, the question of the Sixth Street extension is up, and I personally am not in favor of it, though both the other commissioners are in favor of granting the request of the Sixth St. property owners. The last plan calls for the straight extension of Sixth St. instead of following the jog from Date St. north. The lower Sixth St. property owners have expressed themselves as willing to stand the expense, which will be about \$30,000 or \$35,000. I would like to hear from you on this, if you can see your way clear to give me an opinion.
