This shows site of exposition looking E. N. E. ly towards the Cuernavaca Mountains. <sup>50 miles away</sup> The group of main buildings is to extend from the bend in the drive where the arrow points down (right) to near the High School and from the houses below the arrow back to near the long band of dark euca-

lyptus trees. The dark shadow to left of bend in drive is the cornada in which will be the Spanish garden, (30 acres). This will be crossed by the 7 arched Spanish bridge, 430' long, 50' high. The big building with blank gray walls is the Union Bldg. That above it is the U.S. Grant Hotel that over the words "Photo Co." is the old court house, (addition to) J.C.O.
