My Dear Fred:-

I wish to make clear to you the arrangement as I now understand it in regard to engaging Mr. Frank Sessions which Mr. Olmsted and Mr. Allen decided on day before yesterday. Mr. Sessions is at present engaged simply to carry on the work on the North boundary. When Mr. Allen knows his capacities better the arrangement I reported to you in my letter of March 16 may be put into effect. When we begin the planting in a few days we will use Cumming, Thiene, and if necessary Donald as you advised. I think we will be planting by the middle of next week. A large part of the ground will be ready then so it will only depend upon whether the stock arrives the first of next week or not. All the outside Nurseries have written in that they could not dig the stock until the weather was better. Railroad washouts forced Santa Barbara to take back stock which had already been shipped and wait a week before re-shipping. Letter this morning says it is now on the way. We all feel much more encouraged as the plowing etc. is going along well.
