I approve plan fifty-three C with one important and several minor modifications. Important change is to add bridge across Spanish canyon preferably close to northeast end of Cabrillo Bridge and at same elevation and with drive and walks to plaza passing south of California State Building. As minor modifications will not seriously affect preliminary estimate which should now be made I will discuss them in a letter. California building better not go forty-five feet down side of canyon. Fear it would be out of scale as canyon is only eighty-five feet deep. Cross drive south of Administration building is needed.
