Dear Sir:-

In reference to the bill for Hardware and Bell for  
the Fine Arts Building, the following action was taken:-

"Upon motion, duly made and carried, Mr. Winslow  
was instructed to notify Mr. Goodhue that the  
Two Thousand (\$2000.00) Dollar appropriation  
for Hardware included the cost of the bell.  
Furthermore, that if the order was placed with  
Sargent & Company, same must be billed through  
the Western Metal Supply Company, their San  
Diego representatives, Said order for Hardware  
and Bell must not exceed Two Thousand (\$2,000.00)  
Dollars F.O.B. San Diego, including five (5%) per-  
cent commission for the Western Metal Supply Co."

The above action was taken at the regular meeting of the  
Board of Park Commissioners January 9th, 1914.
