EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE --- May 27, 1913.

In reference to the naming of buildings, walks, streets, roads, etc.:

"Moved by Judge Sloame, seconded by Mr. Allen, that the matter of naming the buildings, streets and walks of the Exposition be referred to the Buildings and Grounds Committee for their recommendations. Motion carried."

A special meeting of the Buildings and Grounds Committee of the Panama-California Exposition was held in the Directors' Room of the Administration Building on the Exposition grounds, Wednesday at 4:00 o'clock P.M., May 28th, 1913.

Present:- Messrs. R. C. Allen (presiding), Carl Ferris, George
W. Marston, and Thomas O'Hallaran of the committee; Director of Exhibits
Hewett, Director of Works Allen and Secretary Penfold.

The minutes of meeting held November 14,1912, were read and approved.

Chairman Allen stated that the meeting had been called for the purpose of correcting the names of the buildings, roads, etc., on the Exposition grounds, if deemed advisable, and to submit their recommendations to the Executive Committee; whereupon he asked Director of his Exhibits Hewett to submit this recommendations as regards the names of the walks and roads, which follow:

"Proposed Corrections in the Spanish nomenclature of the Exposition grounds:

Change Puente Espagnol to La Puente Espanola.

- " Prado to El Prado.
- " The Isthmus to El Istmo.
- " Calcada Cabrillo to Camino de Cabrillo.
- " Avenida Internacional to Camino de los Estados.
  Name East fork Camino de Cabrillo, Camino de Viscaino".

Moved by Mr. Luce, seconded by Mr.O'Hallaran, that we recommend that the name of "Calcada Cabrillo" be changed to "Camino de Cabrillo".

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Ferris, seconded by Mr. O'Hallaran, that we recommend that the name "Avenida Internacional" be retained. Motion carried, Mr. Marston voting "No".

Moved by Mr. Luce, seconded by Mr. O'Hallaran, that we recommend that the East fork of "Camino de Cabrillo" be named "Camino de Viscaino". Motion carried.

Chairman Allen asked Director of Exhibits Hewett to submit his recommendations as regards the names of buildings, which follow:

"Proposed alterations in nomenclature of buildings:

Fine Arts change to Ethnology.
Mining change to Science and Education.
Machinery change to Arts and Crafts.
U.S.Government change to Motor Transportation.
Botanical change to Botany.
Electricity change to Home Economy.
Foreign Liberal Arts change to Tibe Foreign Arts.
Domestic Liberal Arts change to Commerce and Industries.

The name of the first building in the list was discussed at some length and Director of Exhibits Hewett stated that it was not essential that this building be named for the present, whereupon it was moved by Mr. Marston, seconded by Mr. Luce, that these suggestions for the names of the buildings be adopted and recommended as a whole, with the exception that the first or Ethnological Building be not named for the present. Motion carried.
